## **KEPPEL AMFELS WATER LINE RELOCATION**

September 12, 2017

### 1. CHANGES TO CONSTRUCTION PLANS

- a. The **Construction Plans** have been modified. The more prominent changes are:
  - a) The owner will arrange for the installation of a temporary railroad crossing near the Northeast corner of Keppel AmFELS to allow the contractor access to the area next to the fence for pipe installation. The approximate location of the crossing is now shown in Sheet 2 of the drawings.
  - b) A 16" X 8" Cross (Sheet 3) with corresponding valves has been added along the pipe segment paralleling State Highway No. 48, East of the main entrance to Keppel AmFELS.
  - c) The proposed 12" Water Line on the East side of Keppel AmFELS has been moved from the West side of the drain ditch to the East side of Marine Way Drive (Sheets 3 and 4). The pipe material for that segment has been changed from DR-18 to DR-25.
  - d) A detail has been added in Sheet 5 indicating the geometry of steel casing and carrier pipe under railroad tracks.
  - e) Other labeling and syntax modifications/clarifications have been made.

### 2. CHANGES TO BID PROPOSAL

- a. The **Bid Proposal** segment of the bidding documents has been modified. The modified form accompanies this Addendum. The modifications include:
  - 1) Bid Opening date and time (Page BP-1 of 3).
  - 2) Bid items have been revised to conform to changes in construction plans (Page BP-2 of 3).
  - 3) Issued Addenda have been listed (Page BP-3 of 3).

### 3. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- a. Connections (tie-ins) to the existing 8" water line at the proposed cross, and connections (tie-ins) to the existing 10" water lines both at the West and East ends of the project, shall be subsidiary to other bid items, and shall not be paid for separately.
- b. All personnel and staff (workers, supervisors, equipment operators, etc.) from the successful bidder that will be working in the proximity of rail shall be required to undergo training by Brownsville-Rio Grande Railway to insure all safety protocols are followed.
