

Addendum No. 1

BND BULK CARGO DOCK IMPROVEMENTS

May 22, 2018

This addendum is part of the Bidding documents and will be incorporated into the Contract Documents as applicable.

1. BID FORM DOCUMENT

- a. Revised Bid Form Document (Sheet 1 of 3) as follows:
 - **Revise number of calendar days to fully complete project from 331 to 231**

2. REVISED TIMBER PILES SPECIFICATION (6966003-40900-000006)

- a. Revise Timber Piles Specification (Page 5 of 8) as follows:
 - **Section 2.1, A., 2. - Revise Size Basis from “minimum 12 inch butt” to “minimum 14 inch butt”**

3. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION & MISCELLANEOUS CLARIFICATIONS

- a. Spiral Weld Pipe will NOT be permitted on this project.
- b. The plate ring for the spool piece that the cell fender bolts to on the fender monopiles must be a minimum of 1 inch thick (plate provided by Kirti International)
- c. Regarding Detail 3 on Drawing No. 6966-S-003
 - i. The connection of the new HP12x53 section to the lower remaining section at Elev. – 4’ may be bolted or welded as long as the load can be properly transferred to the remaining pile section and the member does not lose any of its load carrying capacity. This connection must be a full moment connection.
 - ii. Engineering calculations showing the load carrying capacity of the connection are required to be submitted. If the connection is welded, weld inspection data will be required to be submitted.
- d. Regarding Drawing No. 6966-S-002
 - i. There is NO additional geotechnical data available.
 - ii. The monopile should be driven to specified depth in accordance with contract drawings. Contractor is responsible to size pile hammer accordingly to drive pile to full depth.
- e. Non-destructive testing (NDT) is required on 100% of weld locations.
- f. A Full Penetration Weld is required for the connection of the HP12x53 to the existing pile cap (Reference 6966-D-005 thru D-007).

These price(s) are firm and shall not be subject to adjustment provided this Proposal is accepted within ninety (90) days after the time set for receipt of proposals.

BIDDER hereby agrees to commence work under this contract on or before a date to be specified in a written "Notice to Proceed" to be issued by the OWNER and to fully complete the project within 231 calendar days, as defined in the specifications. BIDDER further agrees to pay as liquidated damages, the sum of Two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars for each consecutive calendar day thereafter as hereinafter provided in Article 3 of the Agreement.
