

Addendum No. 1

PUBLIC VESSEL ASSEMBLY AND ERECTION PAD

November 9, 2018

1. CHANGE TO THE BID PROPOSAL SECTION

- a. The original Item #7 was renumbered to #8.
- b. A new Item #7 was added to provide for vertical adjustment of the 12-inch storm sewer inlets, all depths.
- c. Items #9, and #10 have been added to provide for the preparation and implementation, respectively, of the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP).
- d. A revised **Bid Form** is included with this **Addendum No. 1**.

2. CLARIFICATIONS AND ANSWERS TO BIDDERS' QUESTIONS

- a. The following table provides answers to questions posed by people that attended the mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting. Sheets C100 AND C101 (the civil drawings) are included with this addendum. The revised **Bid Form** section with the above described modifications is also included.

BIDDERS' QUESTIONS	BND'S RESPONSES
1. Detail 1, who will remove pipes along the South side of the proposed conc. pads?	The conc. pads will terminate just short of the existing pipes. There is no need for removal.
2. Detail 3, How much effort must the contractor invest on the repair of the beams?	Repairs to the beams are AmFELS' responsibility. They will repair the beams in advance or coordinate repairs with a contractor.
3. Is the contractor responsible for the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan?	Yes. As indicated above, SWPPP Bid Items have been added to the Bid Form.
4. Is there an engineering estimate?	Yes, there is an engineer's opinion of probable cost: Range is \$3 Million to \$10 Million.
5. Does project require any permitting?	No USACE permit is required. USACE letter to that effect is attached.

The BIDDER, in compliance with your invitation for bids for the "**PUBLIC VESSEL ASSEMBLY AND ERECTION PAD**" project, having examined the drawings and specifications with related documents and the site of the proposed work, and being familiar with all of the conditions surrounding the construction of the proposed project, including the availability of materials and labor, hereby proposes to furnish all labor, materials and supplies, and to construct the project in accordance with the contract documents, within the time set forth herein, and at the attached unit prices. These price(s) are to cover all expenses incurred in performing the work required under the contract documents, of which this proposal is a part. These price(s) are firm and shall not be subject to adjustment provided this Proposal is accepted within ninety (90) days after the time set for receipt of proposals.

BIDDER hereby agrees to commence work under this contract on or before a date to be specified in a written "Notice to Proceed" to be issued by the OWNER and to fully complete the project within 60 calendar days, as defined in the specifications. BIDDER further agrees to pay as liquidated damages, the sum of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars for each consecutive calendar day thereafter as hereinafter provided in Article 3 of the Agreement.

BIDDER agrees to perform all work for which he contracts as described in the specifications and as shown on the plans, for the attached unit prices:

BIDDER agrees that this Bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids.

The undersigned hereby declares that only the persons or firms interested in the proposal as principal or principals are named herein, and that no other persons or firms than are herein mentioned have any interest in this Proposal or in the contract to be entered into; that this Proposal is made without connection with any other person, company, or parties likewise submitting a Bid or proposal; and that it is in all respects for and in good faith, without collusion or fraud.

Upon receipt of written notice of the acceptance of this Bid, BIDDER will execute the formal contract attached within ten (10) days and deliver the Performance and Payment Bonds and Insurance Certificates as required under the GENERAL CONDITIONS. The Bid security attached in the sum of _____ (\$ _____) is to become the property of the OWNER in the event the contract, bonds, and insurance certificates are not executed or delivered within the time above set forth, as mutually agreed to liquidated damages and not as a penalty for the delay and additional administrative expense to the OWNER caused thereby; otherwise the Bid security will be returned upon the signing of the contract and delivering the approved bonds and insurance certificates.
