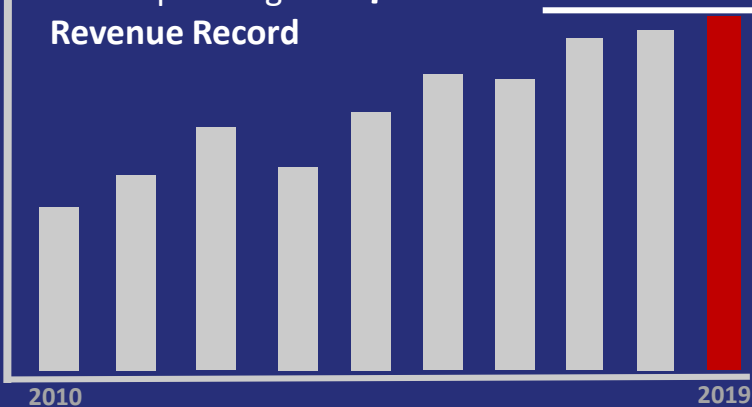

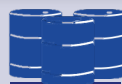
Third Consecutive Total Operating Revenue Record

Completion of new **Liquid Cargo Dock 6**



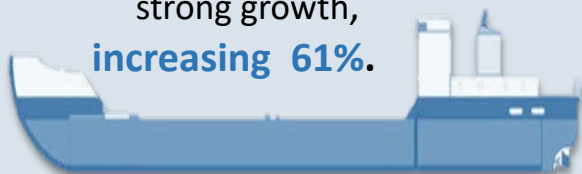

MAKING FUTURES



Truck traffic jumped from 600 tankers daily to almost **1,300**.
