



**The Port Entry Permit- Trucks is governed by the Port of Brownsville
Tariff No. 6, Section Four Licenses and Permits Item 450**

Daily Port Entry Permits and Annual Port Entry Permit- Trucks

All tractors and/or tractor-trailer combinations are required to display a valid Port Entry Permit to obtain entrance to the secured area of the Port of Brownsville.

- **DAILY** Port Entry Permits will be available for **\$3.00**.
- **ANNUAL** Port Entry Permits will be available for **\$100.00** during the period of February 1 – August 31. (*Permit effective date: 03/01/23 – 02/29/24*)
- **ANNUAL** Port Entry Permits will be available at the ½ Year Rate of **\$50.00** beginning September 1 through the end of February. (*Permit effective date: 03/01/23 – 02/29/24*)
- **ANNUAL** Port Entry Permits for **Port Lessees** will be available for **\$75.00**.

Port Entry Permits will be sold through the Overweight Permit Office during the office hours listed below. Daily Port Entry Permits will also be sold at the Foust Road Entry Gate, South Port Connector Road Entry Gate during the hours listed below and at 550 Entry Gate after hours and on weekends and holidays.

The **Annual Port Entry Permit** will be sold **ONLY** at the Overweight Permit Office during regular business hours.
