Q1	<p>Question: Supplementary General Conditions</p> <p>Supplementary General Conditions paragraph 7. PROTECTION sub-paragraph b. states "Temporary Drainage. The CONTRACTOR shall construct and maintain all necessary temporary drainage and do all pumping necessary to keep the excavation free of water."</p> <p>Clarification: The work advertised is for dredging, and it is not feasible to keep the excavation free of water; please clarify that this language does not apply to dredging activities.</p> <p>Answer: The purpose of this statement is to ensure positive drainage is maintained throughout the duration of the project and to prevent any water from overflowing the existing Disposal Areas.</p>	03/31/2026
Q2	<p>Question: Supplementary General Conditions</p> <p>Supplementary General Conditions paragraph 16. PROTECTION AND REPLACEMENT OF PROPERTY states "Driveways, culverts, storm sewer inlets and laterals, and other public or private property that is destroyed or removed during the construction shall be replaced to its original condition by the CONTRACTOR. Temporary drainage is to be provided as necessary."</p> <p>Question: Will the Port of Brownsville revise this language by replacing "original condition" to "condition of property before dredging and dredging support activities occurred"?</p> <p>Answer: Driveways, culverts, storm sewer inlets and laterals, and other public or private property that is destroyed or removed during the construction shall be replaced to the condition of property prior to dredging and dredging support activities.</p>	03/31/2026
Q3	<p>Question: Supplementary General Conditions</p> <p>Supplementary General Conditions paragraph 28, Guarantee sentence one (1) states "The work shall be guaranteed to be free from defects due to faulty workmanship or materials for a period of one year from the date of issue of the Certificate of Acceptance."</p> <p>Clarification: Due to the nature of channel currents, rainfall events, and external factors beyond Contractor's control, we cannot warrant dredging work past the date of final acceptance. Please revise this sentence to read "The work shall be guaranteed to be free from defects due to faulty workmanship or materials at time of Owner's issuance of Certificate of Acceptance."</p> <p>Answer: Dredging work shall be guaranteed at the time of issuance of the Certificate of Acceptance.</p>	03/31/2026

To: The Brownsville Navigation District, Texas, hereinafter called OWNER.

Gentlemen:

The BIDDER, in compliance with your invitation for bids for the "**CARGO DOCKS 15 & 16 MAINTENANCE DREDGING**" project, having examined the drawings and specifications with related documents and the site of the proposed work, and being familiar with all of the conditions surrounding the construction of the proposed project, hereby proposes to furnish all labor and equipment, and to construct the project in accordance with the contract documents, within the time set forth herein, and at the attached prices. These price(s) are to cover all expenses incurred in performing the work required under the contract documents, of which this proposal is a part. These price(s) are firm and shall not be subject to adjustment provided this Proposal is accepted within ninety (90) days after the time set for receipt of proposals.

BIDDER hereby agrees to commence work under this contract on or before a date to be specified in a written "Notice to Proceed" to be issued by the OWNER and to fully complete the project within (7) seven working days, as defined in the specifications. BIDDER further agrees to pay as liquidated damages, the sum of one thousand five hundred (\$1,500.00) dollars for each consecutive calendar day thereafter as hereinafter provided in Article 3 of the Agreement.

BIDDER agrees to perform all work for which he contracts as described in the specifications and as shown on the plans, for the attached prices:

SUBCONTRACTORS. BIDDER proposes that he will perform the majority of the work at the project site with his own forces and that specific portions of the work not performed by the BIDDER will be subcontracted and performed by the following subcontractors.

CARGO DOCKS 15 & 16 MAINTENANCE DREDGING

BIDDER Agrees to perform all the work described in the Contract Documents for the following Prices (which include any and all applicable taxes and fees):

Tuesday April 7, 2026.

The PORT OF BROWNSVILLE is seeking Dredging Services from a qualified contractor to dredge approximately 20,000 CY of shoaled material from the area in front of Cargo Docks 15 & 16. The bid amount shall include furnishing all plant, labor, equipment, fuel, supervision and performing all maintenance dredging and deposition of material from the Cargo Docks 15 and 16 area to a depth of -45 ft. required with no over dredge depth payment included.

Pricing should include all mobilization/demobilization. Pipeline management shall be subsidiary to other pay items, and shall not be paid for separately.

Material removed by the Hydraulic Dredge will be deposited into Dredge Material Placement Area (DMPA) #7 in the Port of Brownsville. The bid should include the use of excavators and any other equipment needed to install the dredge pipe to the designated placement area and remove it after dredging is complete.

Bidder shall perform daily effluent water sampling during discharge in the placement area, in conformance with U.S. Army Corps of Engineer’s and TCEQ rules, regulations, standards and practices.

The Bidder shall supply a pre- and post-dredge bathymetric survey to verify the dredge depths and volume quantities dredged.

All work is to be accomplished with the highest regard to safety and quality. The successful Bidder shall operate in accordance with rules and regulations established by OSHA, the U.S. Coast Guard, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

Upon receipt of written notice of the acceptance of this Bid, BIDDER will execute the formal contract attached within ten (10) days and deliver the Performance and Payment Bonds and Insurance Certificates as required under the GENERAL CONDITIONS. The Bid security attached in the sum of _____ (\$ _____) is to become the property of the OWNER in the event the contract, bonds, and insurance certificates are not executed or delivered within the time above set forth, as mutually agreed to liquidated damages and not as a penalty for the delay and additional administrative expense to the OWNER caused thereby; otherwise the Bid security will be returned upon the signing of the contract and delivering the approved bonds and insurance certificates.
